GENERAL NEWS

- A. The second midweek Lenten service will be held this Wednesday at 3:30 PM and 6:30 PM. School children can sit with their parents or in groups with an adult supervisor or faculty member. Parents, please communicate with your child if they are attending the Lent service after school. Between services from 4:30-6:00 PM a supper will be provided. A free will offering will be taken.
- B. A meal will be served between the two midweek services. This week the Youth Group will serve Pizza, Salad, Bread, Fruit, Desserts, and Drinks. The meal is served from 4:30-6:00 PM for all those who stay after the early service and for those who come before the late service.
- C. The third quarter ends on Friday. Report cards will be distributed on Monday, March 25.
- D. Spring Break begins this week on Friday at 11:45 AM and will end at 8:15 on Monday, March 25.



- E. The parent custodians for this weekend are Erdmann/Gamez (Mathews) (Grades 5-6). Please note that when parents take their turn cleaning school on a weekend they may pick up a key in the school office during the week before. The cleaning includes doing the duties on the slip posted inside the janitor's closet which is located between the school restrooms. The cleaning also includes the classroom listed with their name.

- F. Our mission project for the third quarter ends on Friday. It is the Wisconsin Lutheran Seminary (WLS). Last week's offering was \$36.66. For the quarter it is \$202.12.



The mission project for the 4th quarter is Ukraine WELS mission. In 1991, the Ukraine claimed independence from the Soviet Union and the Ukrainian Lutheran Church (ULC) declared fellowship with WELS. The ULC continues to face increasingly difficult challenges and an uncertain future in a social climate where the majority of Ukrainians are heavily influenced by the Eastern Orthodox Church and traditions from Slavic mythology. Other challenges include financial pressures brought on by high inflation coupled with a decrease in the financial resources from America that are used to provide support for congregations and workers; increased governmental regulation and at times open hostility; and a history in which biblical stewardship principles have not yet been fully implemented in ULC congregations. In spite of challenges, the ULC continues to work faithfully to proclaim the saving Gospel and to be a voice for confessional Lutheranism in Ukraine.
